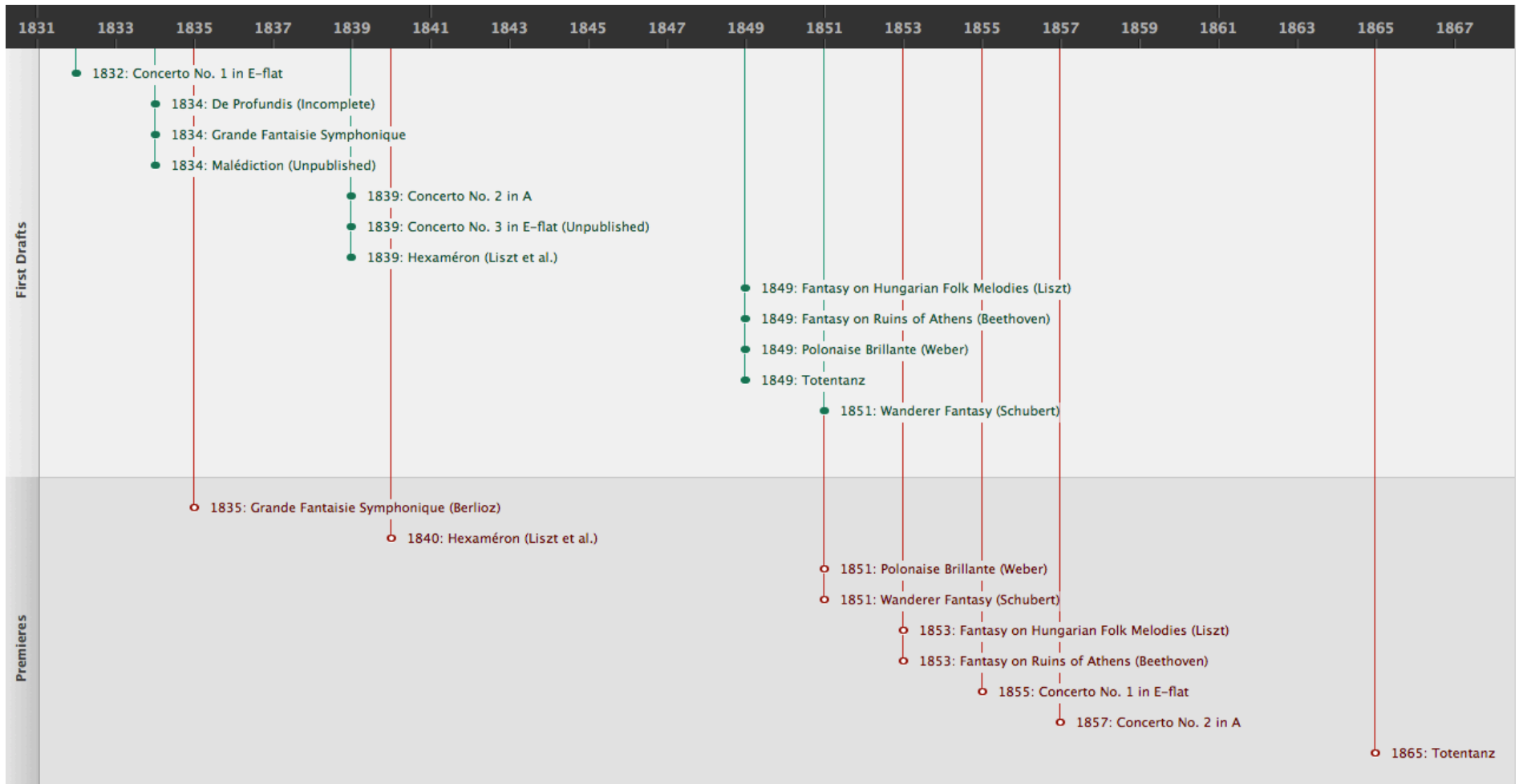


Chart 1: Timeline of Liszt's Works for Piano and Orchestra¹
